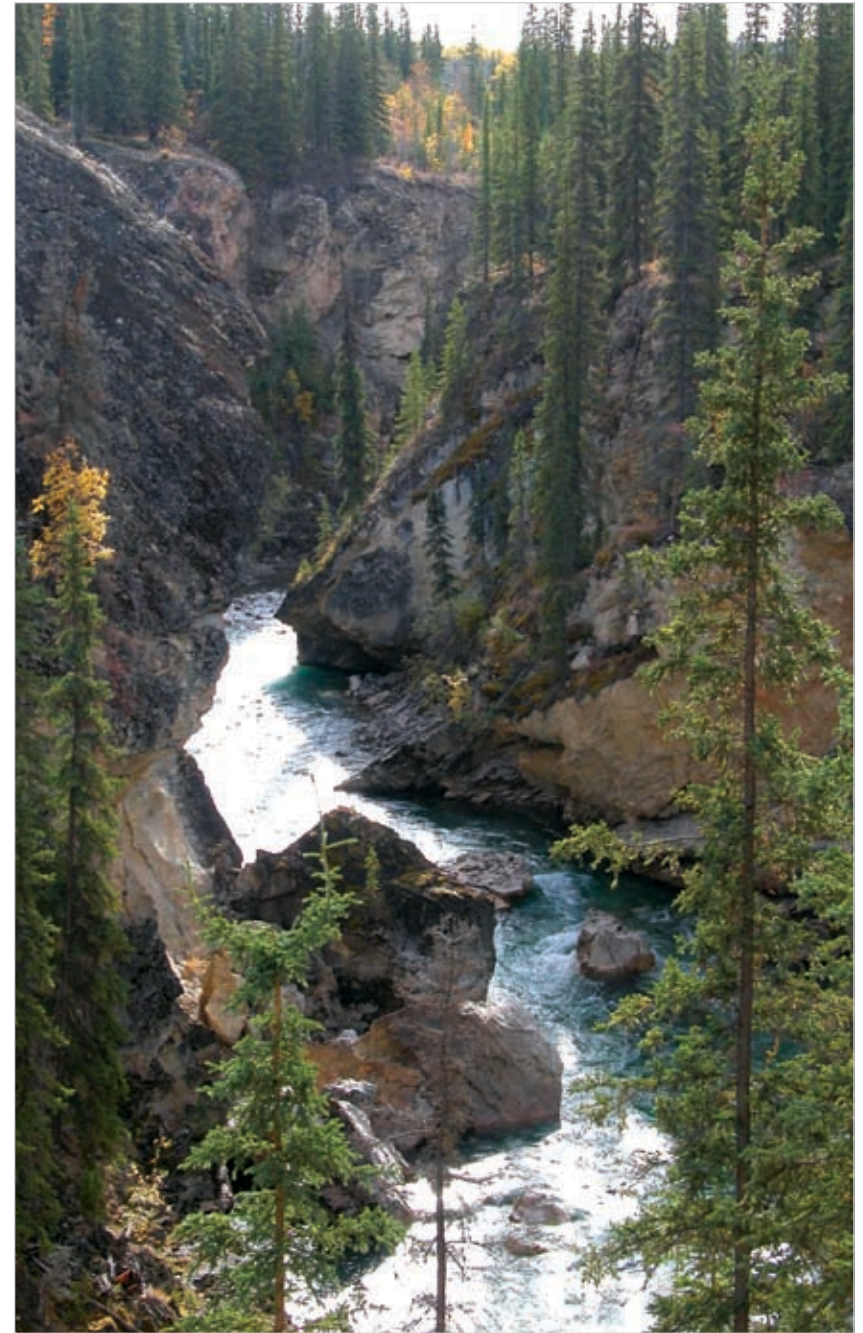
First snow, last snow... and pure drama in between. Summer or winter, Yukon is a land of adventure.

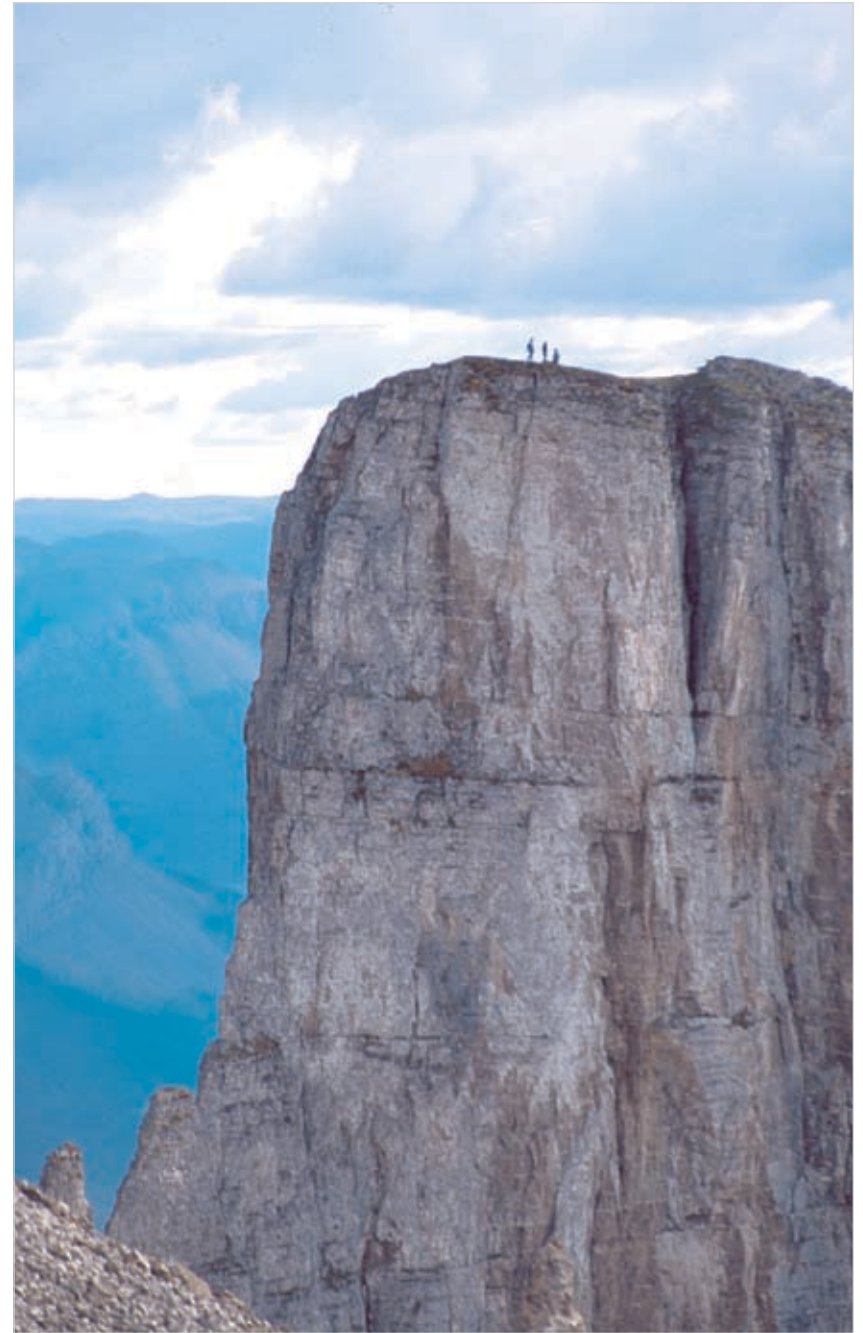








































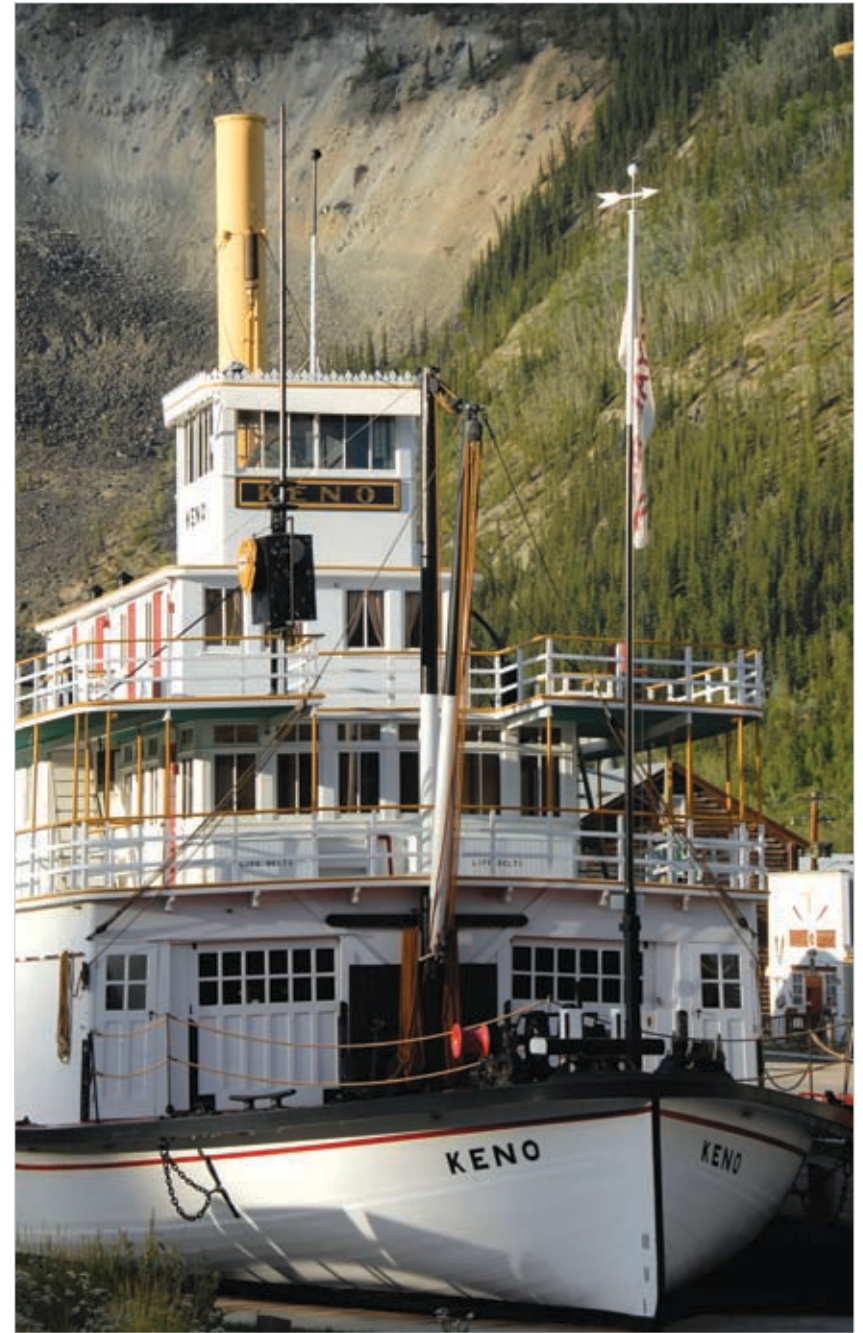
